



Within Microsoft PowerPoint, these keyboard shortcuts can help make your life easier while you are working on your project.

Start Your Slideshow from the Beginning

This shortcut is helpful when you want to view your slideshow from the beginning no matter where you are in the deck at the time.

Operation	Shortcut
Start Slideshow from Beginning	F5

Start Your Slideshow from the Current Slide

This shortcut is helpful when you want to view your slideshow from the slide that you are working on.

Operation	Shortcut
Start Slideshow from Current Slide	Shift + F5

Select All Objects

This shortcut is helpful when you want to select all the objects in the current slide that you are working on. This allows you to more easily group them together to move them together or to see what objects are on the slide (often to delete unneeded objects).

Operation	Shortcut
Select All Objects	Ctrl + A

Group Objects

This shortcut is helpful when you want to group certain objects on the slide together so they can be moved together more easily.

Operation	Shortcut
Group Objects	Ctrl + G

Ungroup Objects

This shortcut is helpful when you want to ungroup objects to work with them separately.

Operation	Shortcut
Ungroup Objects	Ctrl + Shift + G
